Do you know how letters get from place to place? After we put a letter in an envelope and write the address of the person, we must stick a stamp on the envelope. The stamp shows the postman that you have paid for him to deliver the letter. Then you put the envelope in a letterbox. A postman takes all the letters in the letterbox to the big post office.

In the big post office, a machine will arrange the letters that have the same postal code in the same bag. These letters will go to the same places.

The bags of letters are then taken onto trucks. Some trucks take the mail to aeroplanes at the airport. Such letters go to places far away. Other trucks take letters to the smaller post offices close by.

Postmen deliver the letters to the address on the envelope. That's how a letter gets to you!
